### Block of the Month Instructions

SQUARE KNOT BLOCK

Print Fabric: cut 4 strips 2 1/2 x 4 1/2


Cut 4 squares 2 1/2 x 2 1/2

White Fabric: cut 4 strips 2 1/2 x 4 1/2

Cut 4 squares 2 1/2 x 2 1/2

Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the back side of each 2 ½ square.

Take a print rectangle and lay a white square on top, right sides together. Line up the left edges and sew on the diagonal line.




Trim away excess leaving ¼" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle. Make 4
Take a white rectangle and a print square and do the same as above, Make 4
Place a print rectangle on top of a white rectangle right sides together, making sure the triangles are both on the left side. Sew along the top ¼" seam allowance. Press toward print. Make 4
Arrange the 4 matching units as shown.

Sew the top 2 units together and press to the left.

Sew the bottom 2 units together and press to the right.

With right sides together, nest seams and sew together 1/4" allowance.

Makes 8" block





## Vice President's Challenge Mystery Quilt

The 2020 Vice President's (VP) Challenge is a "paint chip" challenge. Photos of the completed projects will be sent to Priscilla for publication in the November Show and Tell. Be sure you take your photo with the paint chip attached with a pin to the project.

The instructions for the VP Challenge are printed below as a refresher.

Please send a photo of your finished piece with paint chip pinned onto it to Priscilla by November 16.

#### **Mystery Quilt**

This year's mystery quilt is only 33" square! There were 7 steps. Because of the pandemic, the instructions were mailed to participants. You will reveal your mystery masterpiece in the November Show and Tell.

Please send a photo of your finished piece to Priscilla by November 16.

VP CHALLENGE—This year will be a paint chip challenge. Those interested in participating will select a paint chip from bag and don't show colors to others. They are to use two (2) of the three colors on the paint chip. They may add one (1) additional color in the project. The project must be at least 20" square. All of the project is to be completed by 1 quilter and try to keep it a secret. The project should be brought to the November quilt meeting in a brown paper bag with paint chip attached via pin to the project.
