Bylaws Proposal

The Board has proposed that our Bylaws change to combine Refreshments and Hospitality committees into one, called "Hospitality".

Our bylaws state "Article IX Bylaws. These by-laws may be amended at any general meeting of the club. Notice and reading of such an amendment must be given to members of the Club at the preceding meeting, published in the newsletter, and read at the next general meeting prior to voting. A two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members present will be required to amend the bylaws."

Therefore, this proposal is presented here for voting at the December 16, 2021 meeting.

These proposed changes are shown below with text proposed for deletion in *italics* and text proposed to add shown in **bold.** Please refer to your membership booklet to see the entire bylaws. This describes the Article in which changes are proposed. Unaffected text is indicated by: "......."

Article VIII: COMMITTEES

All committee chairpersons shall be appointed by the President.

Section 1. Standing Committees

.

Delete: Hospitality - Plan and coordinate refreshments and all other details. Shall purchase necessary refreshment supplies for the regular meetings and the May and December pot lucks. Appoint refreshment committees for the regular meeting and the May and December Pot lucks.

Add: Hospitality - Plans, coordinates and assigns responsibility to furnish refreshments and beverages for monthly meetings, and the clean-up at the end of these meetings. Plans, coordinates and assigns responsibility for all aspects of our annual Pot-Luck lunch and clean-up.

Delete: Refreshment Committee - Responsible for furnishing refreshments, making beverages and cleanup for the month in which they volunteer. May and December meetings will be responsible for organizing the pot lucks, making beverages and pot luck clean up.


