May 18, 2023

Call to Order at 10:10 a.m.by President Sue Riley who led the group in the flag salute.

Recording Secretary: The minutes from the April 20 Meeting were published in the newsletter; there were no corrections or additions. Terry Gomez made a motion to accept the minutes; Karen Ervin seconded it. Motion passed.

Sewing machine in good working order
11" x 18" or larger fabric for body (bright colors recommended)
Thread to match your body fabric
Scissors that clip to the tip
Straight pins
Glue stick
Hand sewing needle (#7 darner recommeded)

The following are helpful if you have them: (If not I have several of each and we will share)
Fray Check
Stuffing fork

Turn-it-All or other turning tool

I will supply the following:
Pattern
Flesh colored fabric for head
Yarn for hair
Polyfiberfil for stuffing
Pens crayons for painting faces
white paint and fine brushes
