We reviewed the Treasurer's Report, and it will be included with this note.


Election of officers: Since there were no new nominations, the Board will remain the same. Committee Chairs are:

December BOM

This month presenter is Laurie Jackson.

Quilt Square

Please refer to the pictures when assembling this block. Square will be 8". Finished/quilted square will be 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Contents:

- 4 2 ½" x 5" Batik strips
- 1 1" x 14.5" Light Turquoise strip
- 1 1" x 14.5" Dark Turquoise strip
- 1 2" x 15.5" Gray strip
- 1 2" x 15.5" Black strip



Decide the order of dark to light for the Batik strips, and cut the following lengths.

- Leave the darkest Batik strip at 5" length.
- Cut the dark/medium Batik strip to 4" length.
- Cut the light/medium Batik strip to 3" length.
- Cut the lightest Batik strip to 2" length.

Cutting:

- Cut all the Batik strips in half lengthwise, to make two 1 1 1/2" wide strips of each color.
- Cut both shades of Turquoise strips to lengths 5", 4", 3" and 2".
- Cut both the Gray and the Black strips so each color has one 7" length and one 8 ½".

Sewing:

- Sew each length of Batik strip to the same length Light Turquoise.
- Sew the other of each length Batik strip to the same length Dark Turquoise.

See photos on following page.

- Please refer to the photo. Sew the 7" Gray strip to the 5" Light Turquoise/Batik section, then to the 4", and the 3", and then the 2". Make sure all the edges are aligned on the left side.
- Now, do the same with the 7" Black strip to the 5" Dark Turquoise/Batik section, then to the 4", and the 3", and then the 2". Make sure all these edges are aligned on the right s

Lay out the triangles on your cutting mat, making sure each triangle is squared up (see photo). Now (see the next photo) showing that the ruler is aligned to make a 45-degree cut. THIS IS IMPORTANT... make sure the cutting line is set right at the inside corner of the 4" Turquoise strip where it meets the 5" Batik strip for both the Light and Dark triangles.

Ironing:

- Iron the Light Turquoise/Gray triangle towards the color.
- Iron the Dark Turquoise/Black triangle towards the Black.

Matching and Assembly:


- Lay the two triangles right sides together, making sure the Black/Gray, outer edges are aligned.
 This may mean that the colored, angled edge may not be exactly aligned, but that is not crucial.
- You will nestle the seams of the Batik and Turquoise to be sure you have nice points (see photo).
- Now sew the ¼" angle seam to finish the square.

Square up, aligning the 45-degree line on your ruler to the angle seam on your square, to trim and finish to an 8" square.


Iron flat.


Good job, you're done.
