#### **Old Business:**

**2024 Committee Sign-ups/Chairmen** - Janet read the Committees still in need of Chairmen. The position of Historian will be discussed at a later date (a Bylaws change if the position is removed).

Parliamentarian - After advertising in the newsletter for this position, we had one volunteer - Stephanie Bullock. Stephanie shared her qualifications with the members. Phyllis Taylor made a motion to appoint Stephanie Bullock as Club Parliamentarian; seconded by Ferral Hubbard. Motion passed.

Proposal to Raise Annual Dues to \$30 - At the October 19 Meeting, Jenny McKinsey proposed raising our annual dues to \$30, and an article was published in the November newsletter. A motion was made by Margaret Smith to raise the Club's annual dues to \$30; seconded by Carlie Attebury. After discussion, the motion passed. During dis-

Linda Petitt made a motion and Lynette Stover seconded, to make three small quilts for Sue Riley's children. Stephanie Bullock amended the motion to add "using batting and backing from the Club," seconded by Carlie Attebury. The motion as amended was passed.

Name Tag Workshop/January 18 - Carmen showed the name tag/holder which will be made by new members or anyone who wants a new name tag. She passed out directions for prep work to be done before the workshop, and will embroider the participants' names.

**Scholarship Fund** - With the recent passing of 3 members, and after discussion, Karen Ervin made a motion to add \$100 each (\$300) to our Scholar-
