Karen E. has been involved in an auto accident, and fractured her ankle. She is to be non-weight bearing for six months. Margaret will cover her duties for her.

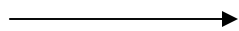
July's program will be a Local Heroes presentation to three brothers. Karen E. wants us to wear red, white, and blue to the July meeting. Let's see who sees this!
